If you're a parent and your child uses Google Chrome, you can use Family Link to set website restrictions and keep them safer online.

Step One

Your child will need their own supervised Google Account. You can find the guidance on how to do this here: <https://support.google.com/families/answer/7103338?hl=en>.

Step Two

Visit Family Link to manage the sites they can visit on Google Chrome. You can do this by visiting: <https://families.google/familylink>

Step Three

Help them sign in to their own Google profile, so that your Family Link choices for Google Chrome are applied. Find out more by visiting: <https://support.google.com/families/answer/7087030?hl=en>.
